


Make an Origami Pallas Cat!

You will need: 1 or 2 square sheets of paper, something to color or draw with

Hint: if you can't figure out a fold, look at the next step to see how it's supposed to look!


2. Fold corners down.







4. Fold down top corner and fold down the points of the ears.

(Pallas Cats have round ears after all!)




5. Flip over.





3. Fold corners outward to make the ears.


6. Fold bottom corner. Tuck it inside the head. Repeat behind.









8. Now let's make the body. Use your other square paper. Fold in half, then unfold.




9. Fold edges so they meet on the crease in the middle (like a paper airplane)



10. Fold in half on the crease.




11. Fold over the tail.



12. Decorate!






Pallas Cats seek areas with rocky caves and burrows to hide in.


